Subject: Application dated 28.04.2014 of the Secretary, Shri Jay Singh Shikshan Sansthan, Fatehgarh, Distt.-Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh to establish a new Ayurveda College in the name of "Shri Babu Singh Jay Singh Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Bhaupur, Bewar Road, Fatehgarh, Distt.-Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh" with 100 seats in BAMS (UG) course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 - Permission letter - reg.

Sir,

In continuation to the Ministry's letter of even No. dated 26.03.2015 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the college with respect to the proposal submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the CCIM in terms of criteria as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2015-16 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/01/2015-EP (IM-1) dated 05.05.2015; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Secretary, Shri Jay Singh Shikshan Sansthan, Fatehgarh, Distt.-Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh to establish a new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of "Shri Babu Singh Jay Singh Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Bhaupur, Bewar Road, Fatehgarh, Distt.-Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh" with intake capacity of 100 seats in BAMS (UG) course from the session 2015-16 under the provisions of the section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970. Therefore, the college may take admissions for 100 UG seats for the academic session 2015-16 subject to the condition that the following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2015:

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- (i) Relevant provisions of the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Sub-Regulation (3) of Regulation 3 and Regulation 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospital) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013 by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015, to get conditional permission for the session 2016-17.
- (ii) Relevant requirements under the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013 (for UG Ayurveda) should be fulfilled.
- 2. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1<sup>st</sup> professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.
- 3. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for II<sup>nd</sup>, III<sup>rd</sup> and IV<sup>th</sup> professionals well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
- 4. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
- 5. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
- 6. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
